



Reelin' for Ryder

- Tournament Director retains the right to refuse any entrants. All decisions by the Tournament Director are final.
- NO GUIDES
- NO FORWARD FACING SONAR
- First place will receive \$7,000 if there is at least 75 boats registered
- In the event there is not 75 boats registered adjustments to payout will be made
- Big bass angler will receive \$1,500 regardless of number of boats registered
- If you didn't register online registration will be held from 4:30 am until 7:00 AM at North Toledo Bend State Park April 25
- First cast at 6:00 A.M.
- Last cast at 2:00 PM
- Scales open at 2:30 PM (possibly sooner)
- Check in by boat number (you can check in early)
 - Boat 1-50 check in by 3:30
 - Boat 51-100 check in by 3:00
 - Boat 101+ check in by 2:30
- Dead fish may NOT be weighed for Big Bass
- Trailering is allowed.
- Boats must have working aerator for live well.
- All boats are subject to random live well checks.
- A participant may fish by themselves or with a partner (2 anglers max per boat; unless you are a boat captain for kids/youth 16 & Under)
- If the boat consists of one adult and one child, both may fish.
- If the boat consists of two children and one adult, only the two children may fish.
- No more than 2 lines in the water at a time.
- Only artificial baits may be used. No live bait.
- Dead fish will result in half 1/2 lb. penalty.
- Short fish will result in 1 lb. penalty and loss of that fish.
- All fish must be atleast 14".
- 5 fish limit per team
- If you are found to have more than 5 fish in your possession you will be penalized by loss of your biggest fish along with a 1 lb. deduction from your total weight.
- All fish weighed in must be caught at Toledo Bend
- A 1 lb. penalty will be added for every minute late to weigh-in established time and will result in a zero score after 15 minutes.
- Fish must be weighed in using ONLY the tournament director's scale.



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- In case of a tie for any of the paid positions, money will be combined and split equally between the two teams.
- No teams will fish closer than 25 feet to another team during the event unless you have consent from the other team.
- Any State/Federal law violations will result in an automatic disqualification.
- Protests must be received by the Tournament Director NLT than 15 minutes after the scales close.
- Life jacket must be worn with kill switch anytime engine is above idle speed
- All anglers are subject to polygraph test
